Conference Focus

- 2. Social and Human Rights Issues including the UN three pillar framework and
- 3. The Environmental Issues

1	Good Governance and Economic Sustainability / National Growth	This will cover a wide range of issues relating to good governance and transparency (public and private sectors), corruption, economic regulations - active labour market policies and labour market regulations; countercyclical fiscal policies, including public investment and public

		works; ■ industrial policies; and ■ robust social provisions delivered and sustained through publicly regulated and locally appropriate revenue- harnessing systems.
2	Universal Social Norms and Values as a tool for Economic Development	This includes Universal social protection norms such as product responsibility respect for human rights and dignity – UN GP; meanings of identity and citizenship; commitment to social justice and equality; international programmes - the Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative, Global Reporting Initiative, ISO 26000, Sustainable Palm Oil Initiative, United Nations Principle for Responsible Investment, etc. Tolerance; and respect for diversity and religion among others.
3	Environmental Sustainability and Economic Growth including physical and biological factors	Environmental management system (EMS) ■ Business related Environmental Human rights issues, ■ Environmental sustainability factors associated with next-generation biofuels; ■ Extractive industries, occupational health and safety, etc.
4	Beyond Compliance: Business sustainability and Human Rights	Consumer rights, compliance with labour/employment laws, human rights in the value chain, etc.

Note that abstract ideas that extend beyond these thematic areas but which are within the broad conference focus will also be considered.

Abstracts for the conference should be emailed to admin@incsr.org and debernardsltd@gmail.com and should be no more than 300 words. The deadline for submission is 23rd September 2016. Authors of accepted abstracts will be notified by 30th September, 2016. Authors of accepted abstracts must also submit the full conference paper of not more than 12 pages and a power point presentation of no more than 25 slides. The deadline for paper submission is 4th November 2016. The LOC will notify Authors of accepted papers by 11th November 2016. Please note that late paper submissions will not be considered.
